Pledge to Recognize Women Peacebuilders

- 2 Provide mediation and negotiation teams with the political and technical support necessary to ensure peace processes are gender-responsive; and
- 3 Provide women peacebuilders with the logistical and financial support necessary to engage meaningfully and safely throughout peace processes.
