Pledge to Protect Women Peacebuilders

- 1 Increase the accessibility of international mechanisms and develop national legal frameworks to protect women peacebuilders and their work;
- 2 Strengthen security policies and procedures to prevent, mitigate, and respond to threats against women peacebuilders on the ground;
- 3 Provide robust security arrangements for women peacebuilders at the peace table and in other international peace and security spaces; and
- 4 Allocate funds, services, and logistical support for women peacebuilders under threat or imminent harm to enable them to continue their work safely.
